➤ **Main Presentation: Pedro Villegas, Director of Community Relations for SDG&E:**

- On September 1, 2013 new gas and electric rates will be in place.
- Due to Sacramento bill passed a few years back, tier 1 and tier 2 can only change a few percentage points. What that means is tier 3 and tier 4 customers will pay the bulk of the new increased electric costs.
- Most tier 3 and tier 4 customers live inland where the need to run the air condition is greater.
- There is a bill being considered to even the tiers, but hasn't moved forward from the committee.
- Mr. Villegas showed ways to reduce your electric use to help with decreasing your monthly electric bill.
