- **Police Report:** Officer Ed Zwibel, Community Relations Officer (858-495-7943):
- Quietest 4 months in years. Very quiet in Del Cerro.
 - Calls for service is going up – writing tickets, parking, etc
 - Activity in Service area (not Del Cerro): stabbing at Stadium Club bar in Grantville, bicyclist was hit by a car in the College Area and PETCO in Grantville was also robbed.
 - Over 6,000 false burglar alarms in Eastern Division and only 1% were valid. Need to get a permit otherwise over \$150 per police visit.
 - IC3.gov – tracks identify thief scams. If you come across scams, report it to IC3.gov

Plaza de Panama in Balboa Park:

Redesigning area – removing cars

- Currently car/pedestrian conflicts
- The goal is to reclaim area – no cars allowed
- Building a 800 stall underground parking structure (275 more spaces than exist now).
