

Del Cerro Action Council Minutes of Community General Meeting on January 26, 2011

President Jay Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. and led the Flag Salute

➤ **January Agenda:** Motion duly made by Jay Wilson, seconded, by Anita Colmie, and carried, the members approved meeting agenda.

➤ **Program:**

Fire-Rescue Department – Del Cerro Engine Company 31:

Jeff Butler and 3 other firefighters from the Del Cerro Engine Company 31 spoke about fire safety and explained the new CO2 detector rules. There should be one detector per sleeping area and floor level. Call the fire dept if the Smoke or CO2 detector alarm goes off. The placement of the Co2 detectors should be high, like smoke detectors. Fire extinguishers should be replaced every few years, even though the pressure indicator reads fine, because the mixture inside cakes up. The fire department responds the most to medical calls. Fires in our area are mostly caused by electrical overloading of old wiring and by uncleaned dryer lint traps.

➤ **Police Report:** Sgt Bill Brown of the Eastern Division on Areo Drive(858-495-7943):

- Parking issues on Lambda due to team sport events – recommend calling 531-2000
- Issues with solicitors – remember they need to have a certificate. If not sure, don't open the door and call 531-2000 and report it.
